

**November 21, 2005**

The Mahaska County Board of Supervisors met on the above date in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the third floor conference room of the Mahaska County courthouse. Present were the following board members: Chairman – Henry W. VanWeelden; Vice-Chairman – Greg Gordy and Member – Lawrence Rouw. Also present were the following: Sue Salisbury, Oskaloosa Herald; Scott Dailey, KBOE Radio; Terry Holub, New Sharon Sun; Donna Leach; Fred Burdock; Sue Brown, Mahaska County Deputy Auditor.

Chairman VanWeelden called the meeting to order with a moment of silence.

It was moved by Gordy, seconded by Rouw to approve the agenda. All present voted aye.

It was moved by Rouw, seconded by Gordy to approve the minutes of November 7<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> with the following change in the November 14<sup>th</sup> minutes: “It was moved by Rouw seconded by Gordy to put the car that the supervisors have been using on an auction at the sale barn. This is an old sheriff’s car and the proceeds will go to the sheriff’s department. All present voted aye. Motion carried.

A payroll change for Emergency Management Department was tabled until the hours worked can be clarified.

No action was taken after discussion of the mileage rate for county employees.

The matter of land acquisition pricing tabled until later date.

Fred Burdock and Donna Leach discussed the Burdock Plat with the board. Mr. Burdock will need to discuss the proposed lot sizes and required drainage systems with the county sanitarian and a surveyor.

The amendment to the Rural Housing Ordinance is in process and a hearing will need to be set following publication of the amendment.

It was moved by Gordy seconded by Rouw to adjourn. All present voted aye. Motion carried.
