RESOLUTION 2012-10-02

This Resolution provides funding for the U.S. 63 Corridor Study allowing continuation and completion of the project.

WHEREAS, THE U.S. 63 CORRIDOR STUDY identifies and documents the location for needed transportation improvements necessary to build and maintain the safe and reliable transportation network essential to continuing and future economic growth in the U.S. 63 Corridor from Iowa 163 to U.S. Hwy 6 and

WHEREAS, Mahaska County originally made application to RPA 15 for \$130,000 and

WHEREAS, an additional \$171,822 of STP "bridge funding" is needed to show the Iowa Department of Transportation that Mahaska County and its partners are committed to seeing the project through completion; and

WHEREAS, Mahaska County's portion of committed STP funds will be reduced upon the receipt of funds from other partners from \$171,822 to \$85,911.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mahaska County Board of Supervisors that an application to RPA 15 amending the U.S. 63 corridor study in the amount of \$171,822 is hereby approved and the level of commitment by Mahaska County shall be reduced upon receipt of contributions from other project partners as they occur.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mahaska County Engineer and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to execute the necessary documentation to fulfill this action and to pursue additional funds from project partners to offset the Mahaska County's bridge funding commitment.
