It was moved by Wanders seconded by Webb to approve the agenda. All present voted aye. Motion carried.

It was moved by Wanders seconded by Webb to approve the preliminary and final subdivision plat for McGee's Acres Subdivision. All present voted aye. Motion carried.

It was moved by Groenendyk seconded by Wanders to approve the 28E agreement with the City of Keomah for FY26. Groenendyk - aye; Wanders – aye; Webb – nay. Motion carried.

It was moved by Webb seconded by Wanders to approve the request of Mahaska Chamber & Development Group to use the Mahaska County Courthouse parking lot from 6:00 am to 11:00 pm on June 14, 2025 (Art on the Square); May 30, 2025, June 6, 2025, & June 13, 2025 (Friday After Five); July 24, 2025 (Sweet Corn Serenade); November 22, 2025 (Turn on the Lights); and December 6, 2025 (Lighted Christmas Parade).
