The Mahaska County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on the above date at 9:00 a.m. in the third-floor conference room of the Mahaska County courthouse. Present were the following board members: Chairman – Mark Groenendyk, Vice Chairman – Steve Wanders, and Member -Chuck Webb. Also present were the following: Madison Garden (County Auditor), Russ Van Renterghem (County Sheriff), Zach Kauffman (County Maintenance), Beth Danowsky

This meeting was live streamed by the Communications Research Institute of William Penn University.

Supervisor Groenendyk opened the meeting at 9:00 a.m. with the pledge of allegiance.

It was moved by Wanders seconded by Webb approved the agenda and to move agenda items two and three around. All present voted aye. Motion carried.

Public Comments: Danowsky presented to the board her intent to start a childcare solution fund to assist with the childcare shortage in Mahaska County. The board was invited to attend the childcare solution committee's meeting on Thursday, August 21st. Garden offered to attend as a representative for Mahaska County.

It was moved by Wanders seconded by Webb to approve the claims for July 2025 in the amount of \$1,421,518.04. All present voted aye. Motion carried.

It was moved by Wanders seconded by Webb to approve the Sheriff's Office Report for July 2025. All present voted aye. Motion carried.

It was moved by Wanders seconded by Webb to approve the payroll change to the Auditor's Office adding Jenny Ball as a full-time employee for the position of Deputy Auditor effective August 4th, 2025. Ball's starting salary is \$50,564.80. All present voted aye. Motion carried.

It was moved by Wanders seconded by Webb to approve Resolution 2025-15 for ISAC Voting. All present voted aye. Motion carried.

Resolution 2025-15
To Designate Voting Representatives for the Iowa State Association of Counties
