The Mahaska County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on the above date at 9:00 a.m. in the third-floor conference room of the Mahaska County courthouse. Present were the following board members: Vice Chairman – Steve Wanders. Also present were the following: Madison Garden (County Auditor), Laura Ayala (Elections Deputy), Scott Van Veldhuizen, and present via phone were Mark Groenendyk (Board Chairman), Heidi Kuhl

Wanders opened the meeting with a moment of silence.

It was moved by Groenendyk seconded by Wanders to approve the agenda. All present voted aye. Motion carried.

Kuhl spoke to the board regarding the resolution providing for the issuance of General Obligation Urban Renewal Loan Agreement Anticipation Project Notes, Series 2025A. It was moved by Groenendyk seconded by Wanders to approve this. All present voted aye. Motion carried.

Garden reported on November 4th, 2025, City/School Election. There were 3,072 ballots cast out of 13,764 registered voters in Mahaska County for 22.32% turnout. There were 967 absentee ballots requested, and 2,105 citizens voted on election day. There were 28 provisional ballots and 1 was rejected for various reasons. The results were read. It was moved by Wanders seconded by Groenendyk to certify and approve the canvass results. All present voted aye. Motion carried.

It was moved by Wanders seconded by Groenendyk to adjourn the meeting at 9:26am. All present voted aye. Motion carried.
